



## SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES FULL FEE PAYING OVERSEAS STUDENTS

(Effective January 2018)

The following fees, charges and expenses apply to all Full Fee Paying Overseas Students (FFPOS) at Trinity Anglican School (TAS). A Full Fee Paying Overseas Student is defined as a student enrolled at TAS for a period of time greater than three months and who is not an Australian National or Resident.

All prices are quoted in Australian Dollars and are inclusive of GST where applicable. Fees are reviewed annually and are subject to change.

**FFPOS enrolment applications will only be considered when submitted together with payment of the Application Fee (non-refundable) of \$150. Students are admitted to TAS on the basis that all fees are payable one (1) Term in advance and within 14 days of the account being rendered.**

**FEE CONCESSIONS**

The following sibling concession is applicable to the younger sibling/s when a family has two or more children attending the school at the same time. The concession applies to Tuition Fees only.

Second child	10% reduction
Third and subsequent children	30% reduction

A fee discount of 2.5% of the annual school fee (including Tuition Fees, Capital Levy and IT Levy) is allowed when annual fees are paid in full by 31 January via BPay or Direct Deposit.

<sup>3</sup> Swimming/Music fees are approximate and will vary depending on the program/instrument. Specific prices are available on enquiry.

<sup>4</sup> Homestay fees are payable one Semester in advance.

<sup>5</sup> Semester 1 homestay students may commence homestay residence on or after Saturday, 20 January 2018 and must conclude homestay residence on or before Friday, 13 July 2018.

<sup>6</sup> Semester 2 homestay students may commence homestay residence on or after Saturday, 14 July 2018 and must conclude homestay residence on or before Friday, 7 December 2018.

<sup>7</sup> Students joining school more than five school days after the start of a semester will be charged on a pro-rata basis.

Students arriving earlier than indicated at the start of the year will incur a further charge calculated on a pro-rata basis.

Students departing later than indicated at the end of the year will incur a further charge calculated on a pro-rata basis.

<sup>8</sup> A Hold Fee is charged if a student wishes to leave belongings in their homestay room during a holiday break.

<sup>9</sup> The Summer Hold Fee is charged if a student wishes to leave belongings in their homestay room during the complete summer break.
