YEAR 11 & 12

The Year 11 and 12 course consists of two major components.

- 1. The Core Curriculum studies: an English Course (English, English as an Additional Language and/or Literature), a Mathematics Course (General Mathematics or Mathematical Methods), and the subjects Christian and Values Education (CAVE), Senior Study and the Flexible Timetable Option(FTO).
- 2. Elective Curriculum studies: students will choose to study four elective subjects which they will study for a two-year period. Assuming there are sufficient numbers, the following Queensland Curriculum and Assessment (QCAA) subjects will be offered:
